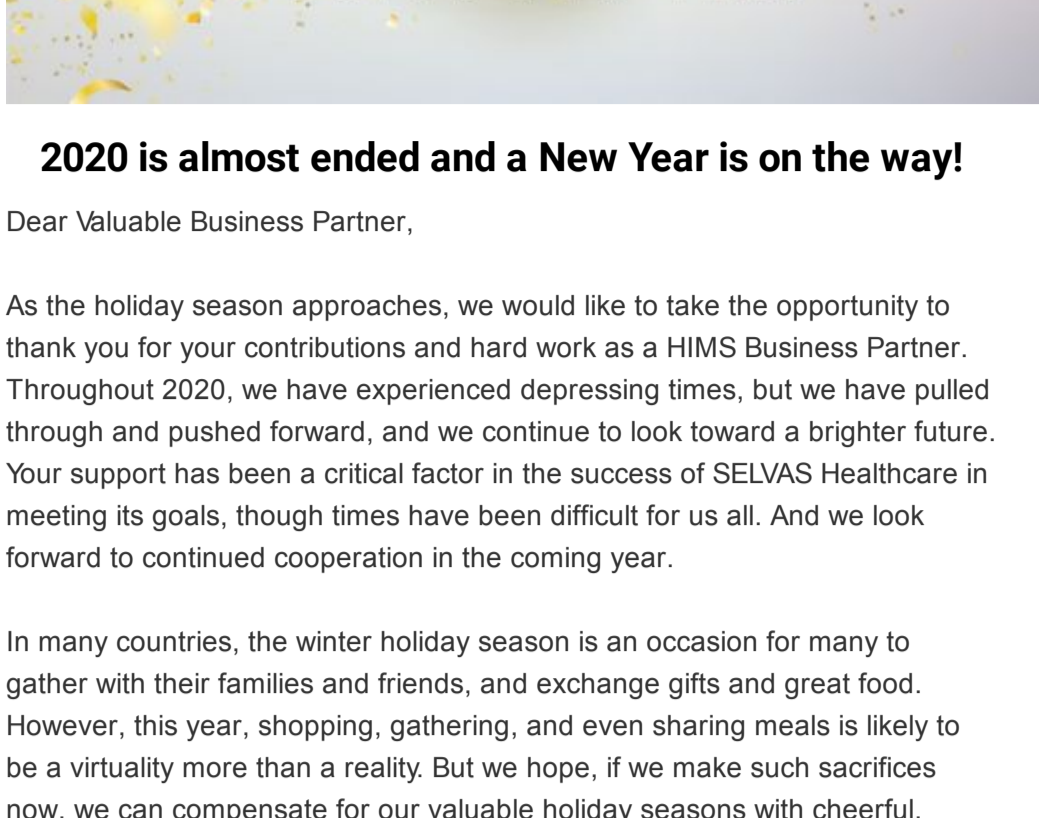

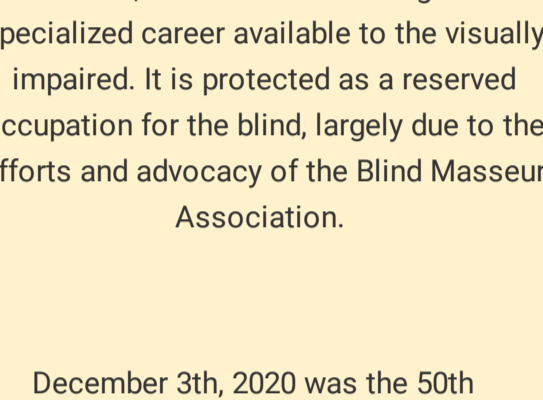
Blind Masseur Association

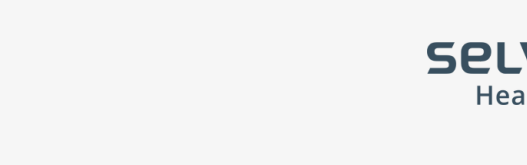
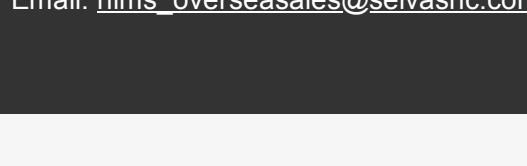
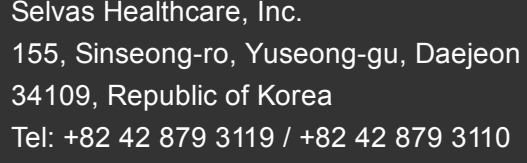
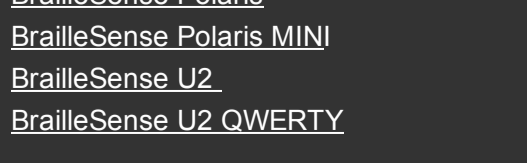
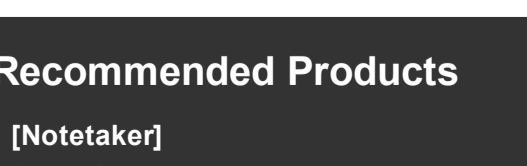
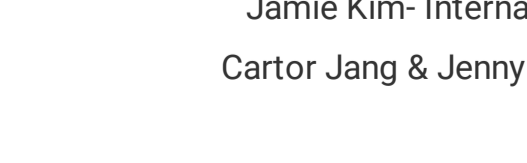
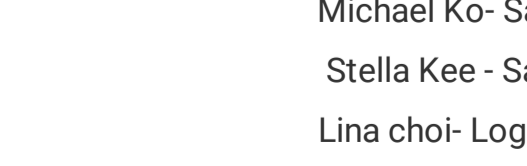
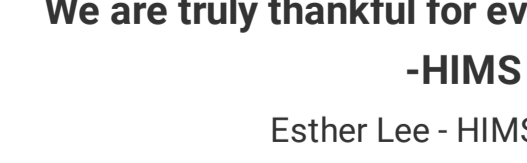
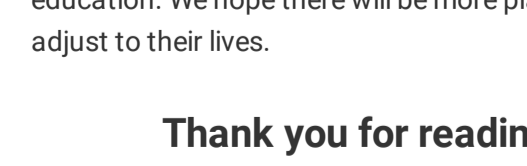
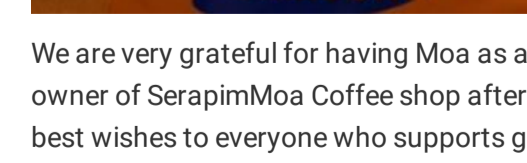
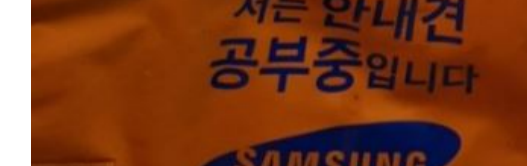
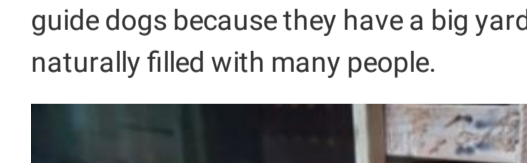
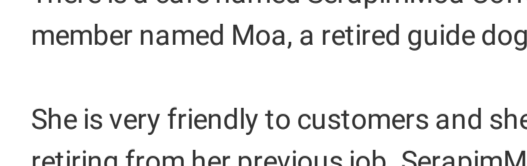
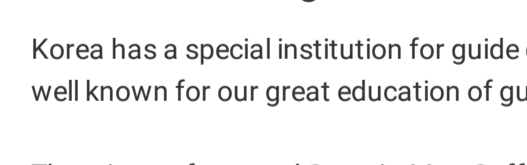
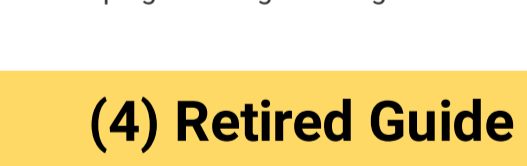
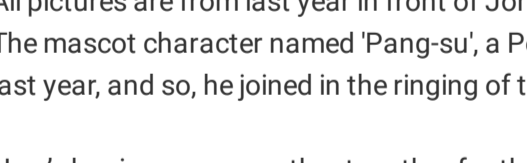
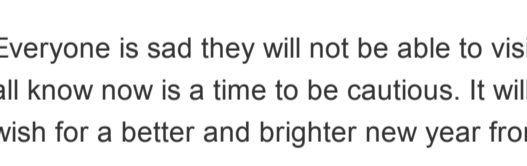
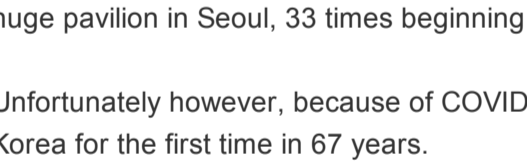
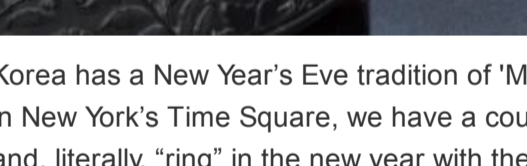
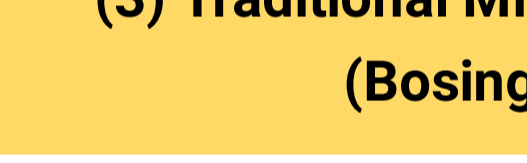
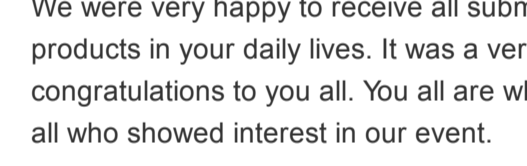
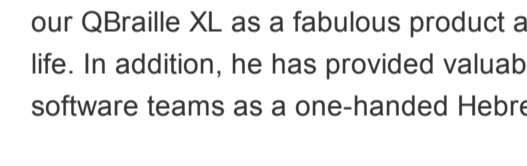
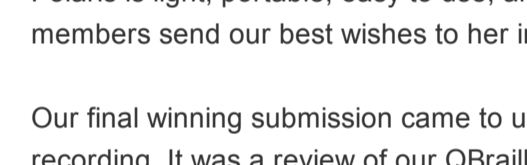
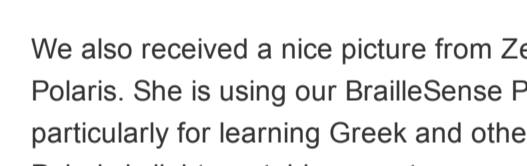
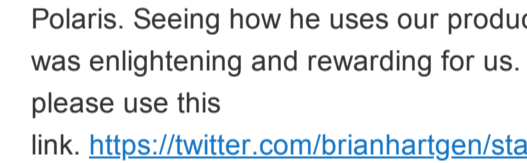
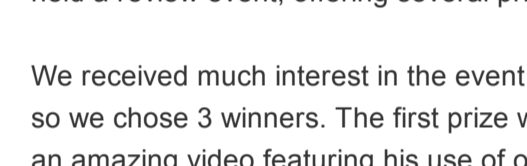
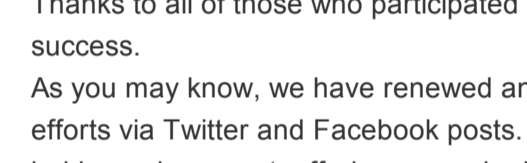
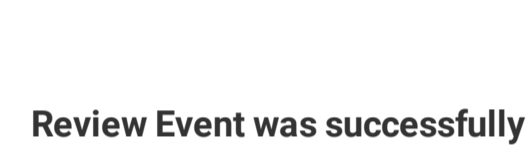


Retired Guide Dog's life

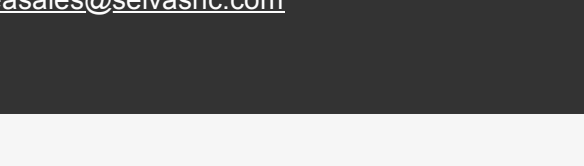
Explore with us the life of a Korean guide dog after retirement.

Unfortunately however, because of COVID-19, this event is canceled everywhere in Korea for the first time in 67 years.

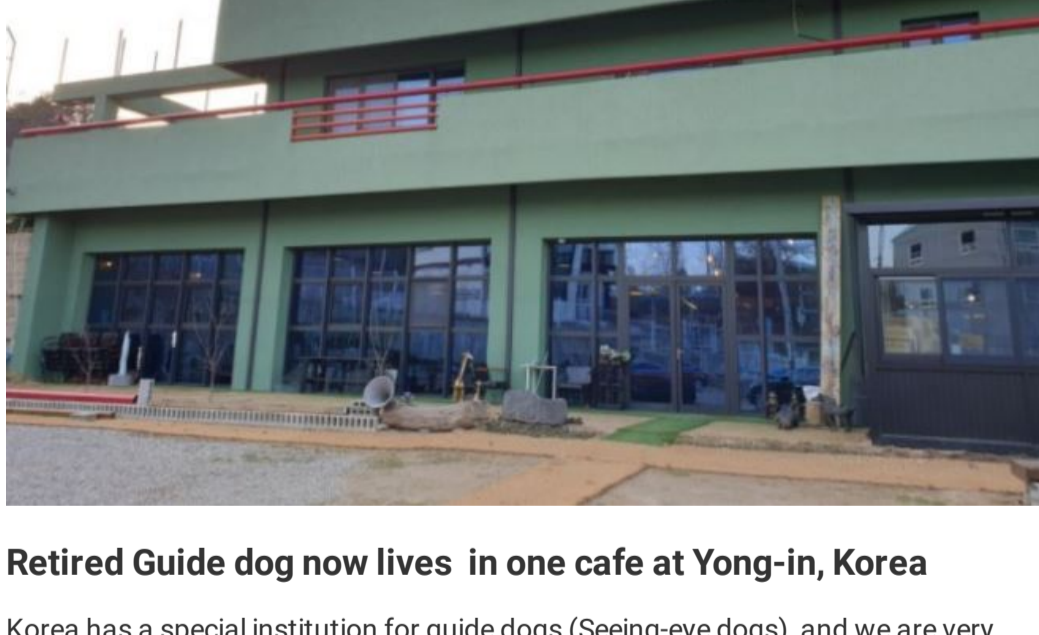
