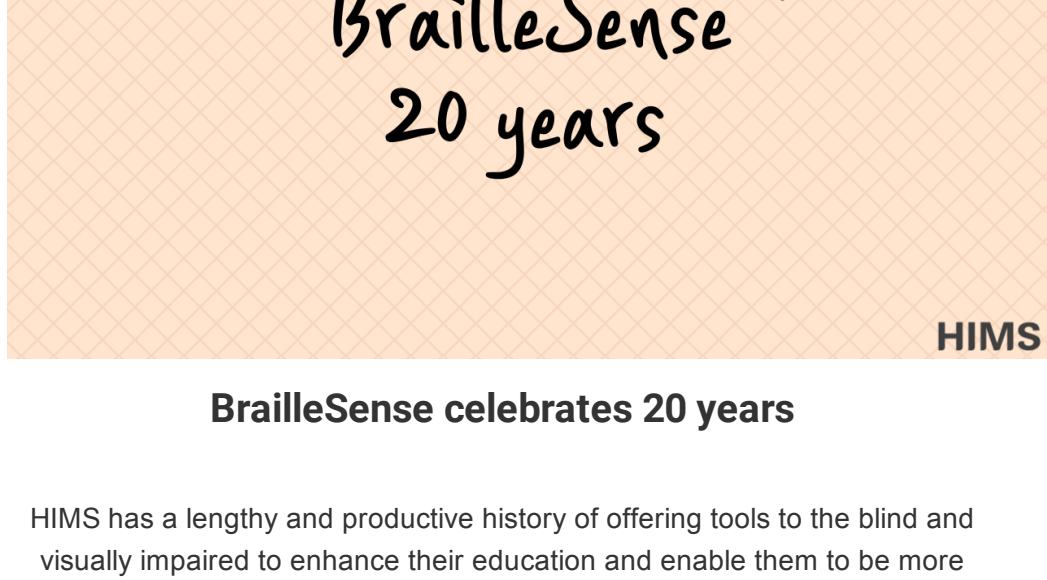

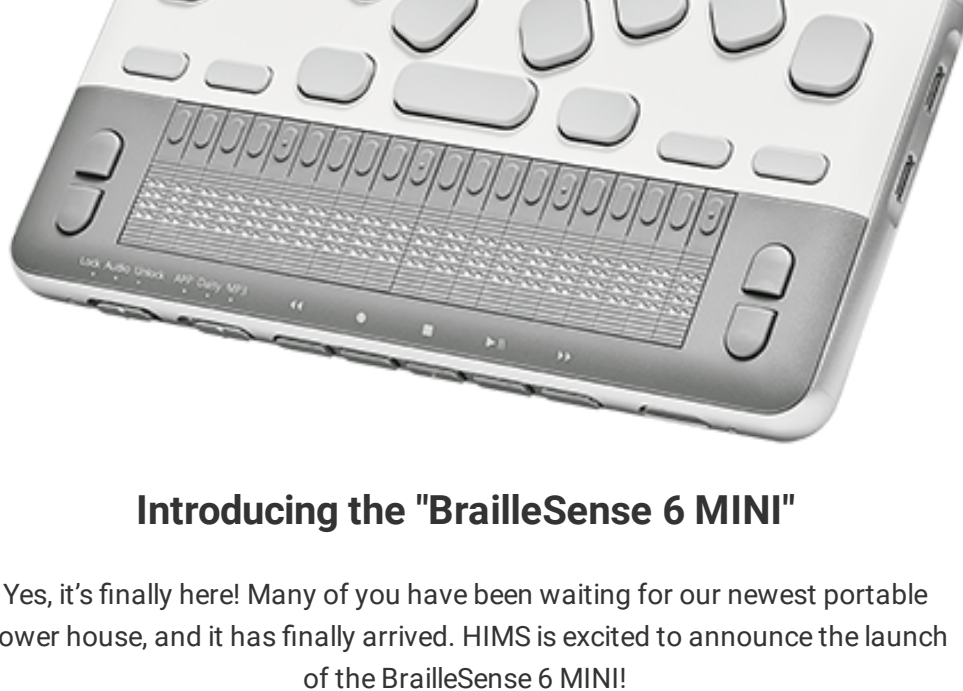

#### Introducing the "BrailleSense 6 MINI"

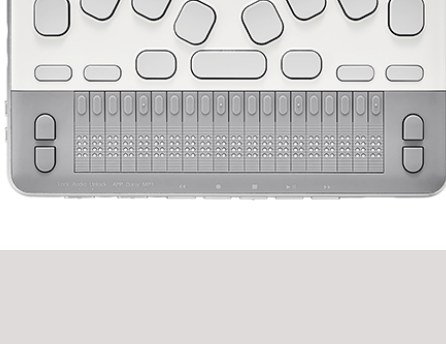
Yes, it's finally here! Many of you have been waiting for our newest portable power house, and it has finally arrived. HIMS is excited to announce the launch of the BrailleSense 6 MINI!

BrailleSense 6 mini may look quite similar to the BrailleSense Polaris mini, but the similarities are only skin deep.

BrailleSense 6 mini has 20 Braille cells and cursor routers, and, as with the BrailleSense 6 32, has 6GB of RAM and 128GB of internal storage.

### Android 10



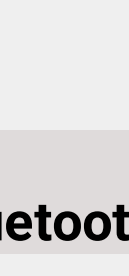

### USB ports



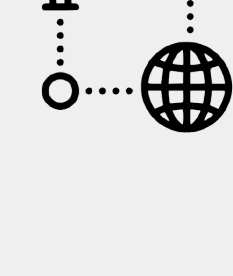

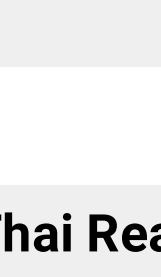
### Bluetooth and Wi-Fi

### Thai Reading and writing braille competition



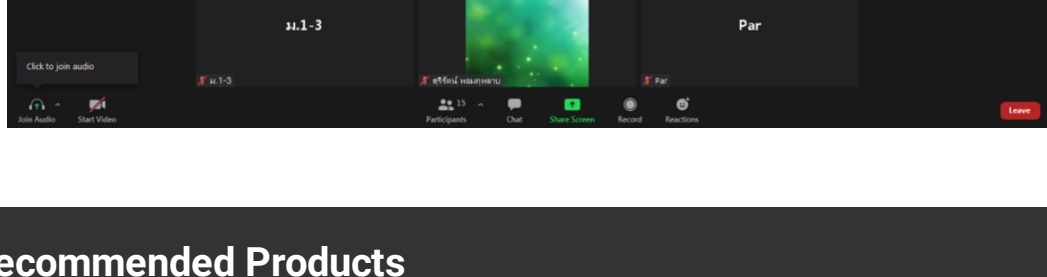
Our partner CFBT in Thailand held a special competitive event for blind students on March 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>, on reading and writing Braille.

Due to limitations caused by the Covid pandemic, CFBT decided to open the competition both on-site and via Zoom.

There were several participant categories, including Thai reading for 6-year-olds, elementary, junior high and high school, and college / university level. Students competed at English braille reading as well.

It was our privilege to support CFBT in this competition by contributing some prizes for the winners, not only as our official distributor, but also as a general advocate of the services CFBT provides in Thailand, and to support the achievement of blind students and encourage advancement of Braille reading skills.

We hope we can visit CFBT and celebrate this competition with them in person in 2023.
